MANY YEARS AGO MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY AND FROM FURTHER AFIELD HAD THE IDEA TO BUILD A MOSAIC USING THE MEDITATIONS OF THE PRIEST, JOSEPH KENTENICH, A PRISONER OF DACHAU, WHO WROTE THESE TEXTS TO HELP OTHER POLITICAL PRISONERS, WHO WERE STRUGGLING TO SURVIVE IN THE HELL THAT WAS DACHAU. AT THE TIME ONE OF THOSE IN THE CAMP SAID THE HELL OF DACHAU HAD BECOME A GATEWAY TO HEAVEN.

PAUL COOPER, A LOCAL ARTIST FROM THE NORTH WEST HAS PAINTED A DESIGN FOR THE MOSAIC. TOGETHER WITH MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY AND FROM LOCAL SCHOOLS WE WILL BUILD THE MOSAIC. VOLUNTEERS HAVE LAID THE FOUNDATION AND THE PATHS LEADING TO THE FUTURE MOSAIC IN A BEAUTIFULLY SITUATED GARDEN . OVER THE LAST FEW YEARS WE HAVE HAD FUNDRAISING FOR THIS PROJECT AND ALL THE PREPARATORY WORK HAS BEEN FUNDED THROUGH DONATIONS. ALREADY NOW PEOPLE COME TO USE THIS GARDEN BECAUSE OF THE OUTLOOK ON TO THE LANCASHIRE HILLS. WE HOPE TO COMPLETE THIS PROJECT IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
